



## *Wine List*

### *White Wines:*

#### ***35 South Chardonnay, Chile – 2,400***

You will find aromas of ripe fruits like peaches, mixed with some citric notes from Casablanca's fruit with fine shades to vanilla and butter.

#### ***Swartland Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa – 2,000***

Full upfront tropical flavours with underlying supporting green pepper and vegetative flavours.

#### ***Boschendal Pavillion Blanc, South Africa – 2,900***

With its dominance of Chenin Blanc, this wine offers a pineapple and peach medium dry palate.

#### ***Angove Long Row Riesling, Australia – 3,250***

A pristine Riesling citrus character, with a hint of lime leaf and peel, floral notes and spice in the finish. A definite nod to off-dry, mid-sweet styling that's so immediately attractive.

#### ***Beach House, South Africa – 2,100***

Playful personality of lemon grass and gooseberries typical to Sauvignon Blanc. A lighter bodied crisp wine perfect for those hot days.

#### ***JP Chenet Blanc De Blanc, France – 2,800***

Limpid and brilliant, very pale yellow with green highlights. Notes of white pear, peach and white flowers. A dry, fine and lively wine, the white pear flavours follow through on to the palate.

### *Red Wines:*

#### ***JP Chenet Cabernet Syrah, France – 2,800***

Intense and limpid ruby red. Notes of cherry, blackcurrant, green pepper, liquorice and spices. A round and lively wine with strong flavours.

#### ***KWV Shiraz, South Africa – 3,500***

This full red wine bouquet suggests ripe berries overlaid with green pepper and spicy flavours.

#### ***Tall Horse Merlot, South Africa – 1,950***

A delicious sleek medium – bodied red with a streak of lithe juicy cherry and plum fruit and a dash of well integrated oak.

#### ***Tilia Malbec, Argentina – 2,700***

The nose offers ripe black fruits, black pepper spice and floral notes. The mouthfeel is full yet soft and supple, with black raspberry and currant flavors mingled with notes of sweet spice and a touch of leather.

#### ***Boschendal The Pavillion Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon, South Africa – 3,600***

An attractive blend with liberal lashings of dark red fruit aromas spiced up with subtle toasty vanilla oak tones



### Rosé Wines:

#### ***JP Chenet Rosé, France – 2,300***

With an appealing salmon-pink colour and powerful red-fruit notes, this rosé is

#### ***Douglas Green Beach House, South Africa – 2,200***

Good looking salmon colour with heaps of strawberry flavours on the nose. The palate finishes clean leaving attractive fruit flavours

### Champagnes & Sparkling Wines:

#### ***Prosecco Blu, Italy – 2,800***

Palest strawberry blond and is enlivened in the glass by masses of tiny light catching bubbles.

#### ***Moët & Chandon Brut "Impérial" France - 14,500***

*Clear, very pale straw, small, active bubbles; very light, almost no aroma, barely suggests flowers, vanilla grapefruit, yeast; light, mild mouth feel; flavors show fruit, slight sweetness.*

#### ***Charles Heidsieck, France – 15,000***

*The First impression is silky smooth, then It starts to melt like light fleshy apricots. Gorgeous melon and enticing rum pastries. A perfect sense of balance, half way between freshness and full bloom.*

#### ***Veuve Cliquot, France – 16,500***

*This vintage still showing some sulphur. Soft, seemingly rather sweet, with a creamy toffee character on the nose. A fat, rounded mousse, with some nice midpalate grip, Powerful and complex, offers an "aromatic" rare brand remembered for long*
